Astrid Lindgren, a famous Swedish author of children’s literature, is best **known** (0) for her books about *Pippi Longstocking*, *The Children of Noisy Village* and *Karlson on the Roof*. Her popular picture books include *Goran’s Great Escape*, *A Calf for Christmas* and *In the Land of Twilight*.

Astrid Lindgren’s books have sold around 145 million copies worldwide and have been translated into over 90 **languages** (1).

Astrid Anna Emilia Ericsson was **born** (2) on the 14 November 1907 to Samuel August Ericsson (1875-1969) and Hanna Jonsson (1879-1961). She grew **up** (3) on Näs farm near Vimmerby, in the county of Småland in southern Sweden. She had a happy childhood on the farm and her parents created a loving and secure home for their children.

Astrid **had** (4) two sisters, Stina and Ingegerd, and one brother, Gunnar, **was** (5) became a member of the Swedish parliament. Astrid and her siblings helped the maids and farmhands **work** (6) everyday work on the farm. It was in the kitchen of one of the farmhands that Astrid heard fairytales and stories **which** (7) awoke her love of books.

At school, Astrid was good **at** (8) writing and at the age of thirteen she got a story published in the Vimmerby Times (Vimmerby Tindingen). When she finished school, the Editor-in-Chief of the Vimmerby Times employed her on a voluntary basis. A Celebration of Kid Inventors



A special event in New York City honors Kid Inventors' Day

When Alexis Lewis was 7 years old, she went with her mother, sister, and grandparents, on a trip to explore different parts of the country. During their many hours on the road, her grandfather, a rocket scientist, would tell her many fascinating stories about science.

When Alexis was 17, she participated in the 2017 Kid Inventors' Day event held in New York. Alexis was one of seven kid inventors who attended the event, which was sponsored by the school and software company Autodesk. With an audience of 50 people in person and more than 100 others tuning in on Facebook Live, Alexis talked about her award-winning invention, the Bambo Travois. It is a lightweight device made of bamboo, a net rope and wheels. A person can use the travois to carry someone else while walking long distances. Alexis invented the device after learning from her parents that Somali families were unable to carry their hungry children to far-away refugee centers.



The travois, for which Alexis has a patent, is used in Africa to transport sick people to villages with medical centers.
