



- A. Under the continents and oceans, the Earth's surface is made up of moving plates. Sometimes, these plates run into each other, making those parts shake.
- The Earth spins around the Sun, but it also twirls around itself every 24 hours. At night, your part of the world is turned away from the sun, so the light can't reach you. At that time, it's day on the other side of the world.
- Almost 14 billion years ago, there was a big bang. It created everything in the Universe. Our Earth, Sun and Moon formed much later, 4.6 billion years ago. Today, there are still stars and planets born every now and then.
- The animals and plants that died millions of years ago in the sea, sank to the bottom where they were covered with mud. Through the pressure and the heat of the Earth, they became oil.
- The Earth was made when many asteroids crashed into each other. The Earth became bigger and bigger and gained gravity. Gravity pulls on all sides of the planet, puling the Earth into its round shape.
- Actually, the sky doesn't have a colour at all. But sunlight has all colours. When it reaches the Earth, the air in our sky spreads all that light.
- Deep inside the Earth, it's so hot that rocks melt. Sometimes, this melted rock (or magma) is pushed up through the centre of a volcano, making a blast. Once it is out of the volcano, the magma is called lava. The lava than cools and becomes rock again.
- H. These aren't stars, but meteors. A meteor is a rock in space that falls towards the Earth. It burns up in our atmosphere, creating a streak of light.
- The daily tides happen because the Moon pulls on the Earth's water through the Moon's gravity. They are also made by storms and earthquakes.
- Thanks to gravity. This is a force that pulls everything on the Earth towards the ground.


